

SHALK questioned me to determine if the results of such a test would be used for anything of value in this investigation. My response was that it may assist the Minister of Justice Kim CAMPBELL in making a decision on what to do with this Application. What if he failed? etc. My position is that every investigative process should be exhausted and decisions on what the final results are can be made at that time.
