CHAPTER S-64 REG 7

The Superannuation (Supplementary Provisions) Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The District Health Boards Designation Regulations*.

Interpretation

2 In these regulations:

- (a) “**Act**” means *The Superannuation (Supplementary Provisions) Act*;
- (b) “**district health board**” means a district health board established or deemed to have been established pursuant to *The Health Districts Act*.
