## CHAPTER C-50.2 REG 16

### *The Crown Minerals Act*

#### **Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Crown Mineral Lands Transfer Regulations, 1999 (No. 2)*.

#### **Crown mineral lands transferred**

**2** The Crown mineral lands set out in the Appendix are transferred to Husky Oil Operations Ltd.
