**CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 111**  
*The Government Organization Act*

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Department of First Nations and Métis Relations Regulations*.

**Department continued**

**2** The Department of First Nations and Métis Relations is established.

**Objects and purposes**

**3** The objects and purposes of the Department of First Nations and Métis Relations are to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister of First Nations and Métis Relations may be exercised and carried out and, with respect to those objects and purposes, to do the following:

- (a) to act as a contact for the First Nations and Métis peoples with the Government of Saskatchewan;
- (b) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to the social development and economic development of the First Nations and Métis peoples;
- (c) to make recommendations with respect to matters affecting the First Nations and Métis peoples;
- (d) to co-ordinate, manage and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to First Nations and Métis governance and land matters.

**Coming into force**

**4(1)** Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on October 1, 2004.

**(2)** If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after October 1, 2004, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
