**CHAPTER V-2.1 REG 5**  
*The Vehicle Administration Act*

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Licence Plate Display Exemption Regulations*.

**Interpretation**

**2** In these regulations, “**municipal corporation**” means:

- (a) a rural municipality within the meaning of *The Rural Municipality Act*;
- (b) an urban municipality as defined in *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*;  
or
- (c) a northern municipality as defined in *The Northern Municipalities Act*.

**Vehicle used by mayor or reeve**

**3(1)** Subject to subsection (2), where a municipal corporation is the registered owner of a Private Passenger Vehicle - Class PV that is provided to the reeve or the mayor, as the case may be, as a perquisite of his office, the municipal corporation is entitled, for the period during which that vehicle is used by its reeve or mayor, as the case may be, to display on the front of the vehicle a licence plate other than the distinctive licence plate issued by the administrator.

(2) A municipal corporation shall obtain the prior approval of the administrator for the design of a licence plate that is to be used pursuant to subsection (1) in the place of the distinctive licence plate issued by the administrator.

**Special Navy League licence plate**

**3.1** During the period commencing on January 1, 1995 and ending on December 31, 1995, a motor vehicle, other than a power unit, may display a licence plate on the front of the motor vehicle substantially similar to the licence plate shown in the Appendix.
