Notice of Application for Revision of Voters List

The Local Government Election Act, 2015, in sections 58 and 59, states:

58(1) Any voter may apply to the chief enumerator at least 15 business days before the day on which a general election is to be held to have the name of any person struck off the voters list on the ground that the person is not eligible as a voter.

(2) Every application pursuant to subsection (1) must be in writing and must specify the grounds on which the applicant alleges that the person is not eligible to be a voter.

(3) An application pursuant to subsection (1) may be made by a person on his or her own behalf.

59(1) In this section, “**applicant**” means a person:

- (a) who is eligible as a voter, but whose name does not appear on the voters list;
- (b) whose name is listed in error on a voters list;
- (c) whose designation as a voter of a public school division or separate school division is incorrect; or
- (d) whose name is listed on a voters list in the incorrect division, ward or polling area.

(2) At least 15 business days before the day on which a general election is to be held, an applicant may apply to the chief enumerator to correct the error or omission in the voters list by filing with the chief enumerator a voter’s registration form setting out the information necessary to correct the error or omission.
