CHAPTER 51

An Act to confirm Bylaw No. 70 of the Town of Indian Head.

(Assented to May 26, 1906)

Preamble

WHEREAS the municipal corporation of the town of Indian Head has by petition prayed that an Act be passed to ratify and confirm bylaw No. 70 of the said town providing for the creation of a debt of one hundred and forty-nine thousand nine hundred and eighty-five dollars (\$149,985.00) for the purpose of providing a water supply and water works system, constructing a sewerage system and building and operating an electric light and power plant;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of said petition;

Now therefore His Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Bylaw No. 70 ratified

1 Bylaw No. 70 of the town of Indian Head is hereby ratified and confirmed and all acts done and contracts made thereunder or in connection therewith are hereby declared to be as legal, valid and binding as if the same had been done or made under or in connection with a bylaw passed under the authority of *The Municipal Public Works Act*.

The Municipal Public Works Act to apply

2 The provisions of *The Municipal Public Works Act* are hereby declared to apply to the said bylaw as if the same had been in force at the time of the passing of the said bylaw and as if the said bylaw had been passed under the authority thereof.

Debentures and assessments validated

3 All debentures to be issued under the said bylaw and all assessments to be made for payment thereof are hereby validated and confirmed and are declared to be legal and binding upon the said municipal corporation and the ratepayers thereof.
