CHAPTER 98

An Act to extend the Time for Issuing Debentures under Certain
Bylaws of the City of Moose Jaw

(Assented to February 4, 1920)

Preamble

WHEREAS the city of Moose Jaw has passed bylaws numbers 782 and 783 for raising moneys required for certain works and undertakings, particulars of which are as follows:

No.	Date of Final passing	Purpose	Amount	Debentures unissued
782	May 12, 1914	Water mains	\$12,985.00	\$12,985.00
783	May 12, 1914	Sanitary sewers	17,015.00	17,015.00

And whereas the time for the issuing of the debentures authorised by such bylaws was extended from a period of four (4) years to a period of six (6) years, viz.: May 12, 1920, by chapter 73 of the statutes of 1917 (second session);

And whereas it is expedient that the time for the issuing of the said debentures under bylaws 782 and 783 be extended for the further period of two (2) years from the twelfth day of May, 1920;

And whereas the city of Moose Jaw has by its petition requested that such extension be granted and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Debentures under bylaws Nos. 782, 783

1 Notwithstanding anything in any Act or law to the contrary the city of Moose Jaw is hereby authorised and empowered to issue debentures under bylaws 782 and 783 at any time or times within eight (8) years from the said respective dates of their final passing and all debentures so issued shall be as valid and binding on the city and upon the ratepayers thereof and upon all persons whom, and properties which the said bylaws purport to affect as if they had been issued within the time limited therefor by section 304 of *The City Act* of the Province of Saskatchewan.
