**CHAPTER 57**

**An Act to enable the Town of Battleford to borrow Money for the  
Purpose of operating a Flour Mill**

(Assented to March 14, 1911)

**Preamble**

WHEREAS the town of Battleford has by petition represented that it is the owner of a flour mill and elevator and that for the operation of the same it is necessary that the town should be permitted to borrow from time to time a sum sufficient to enable it to keep on hand a considerable quantity of grain and the products thereof;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore his Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

**Loan authorised**

**1** The town of Battleford may from time to time borrow a sum or sums not to exceed in the aggregate \$40,000 or any less sum for the purpose of operating the flour mill or flour mills and elevator or elevators now or at any time here after owned by the said town.

**Security, etc.**

**2** The said town may execute any mortgage assignment or other instrument required for the security of the lender or lenders of such money and may pledge, assign, mortgage or otherwise hypothecate any grain, flour or other goods from time to time held by the said town in connection with the operation of such flour mill or elevator whether contained in such mill or elevator or not and any real estate being part of the site of the said town held by the town for sale pursuant to bylaw or bylaws passed in that behalf.

**Loan not to affect borrowing powers of town**

**3** No sum borrowed pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be deemed for any purpose whatever to be part of the sum which but for this Act the said town might lawfully borrow.

**Use and application of loan**

**4** No sum borrowed under the provisions of this Act shall be used for any purpose except the operation of a flour mill or elevator including the purchase of grain and other goods necessary thereto but no lender of any sum by this Act authorised to be borrowed shall be required to see to the application of the same or any part thereof.
