An Act to provide for exemption from taxation of certain Property of
the Parkland Baptist Schools of Prince Albert in the Province of
Saskatchewan

(Assented to March 29, 1973)

Preamble

WHEREAS the Parkland Baptist Schools of the City of Prince Albert in the Province of Saskatchewan has presented a petition praying for an Act of the Legislature to provide for exemption, effective from the first day of January, 1973, of the property hereinafter mentioned from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation of certain lands and buildings

1 The real property of the Parkland Baptist Schools, being duly incorporated under *The Societies Act*, situate at the City of Prince Albert in the Province of Saskatchewan and composed of:

All that Portion of the South East Quarter (SE¼) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township Forty-nine (49) in Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Second Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan, Dominion of Canada containing 163 acres, more or less according to Dominion Government Survey thereof as shown on a plan of survey of the said Township dated at Ottawa on the 8th day of August, A.D. 1922, excepting 2.51 acres more or less, taken for a roadway as shown on a plan of Record in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District as No. B.N. 944, lying North West of the Northerly limit of the Roadway shown on Plan 68 PA 03643; together with all the buildings erected or to be erected thereon, shall, while owned by the said Parkland Baptist Schools of Prince Albert in the Province of Saskatchewan and used for religious and educational purposes, be exempt from all taxation, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind save and except local improvement levies, frontage taxes and special assessments, levies or taxes.

Coming into force

2 This Act comes into force on the day of assent but is retroactive and shall be deemed to have been in force on and from the first day of January, 1973.
