CHAPTER 67

An Act to confer Certain Powers upon the City of Saskatoon

(Assented to January 3, 1913)

Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the city of Saskatoon praying that the said city of Saskatoon may be authorised and empowered to acquire, hold, use and enjoy the rights, privileges and franchises conferred upon The Saskatchewan Power Company by certain Dominion legislation hereafter mentioned and to apply to the Dominion Parliament for a charter for the development of hydro-electric power on the South Saskatchewan river;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Authority to use franchise

1 The city of Saskatoon is hereby authorised and empowered to acquire, hold, use and enjoy the rights, franchises and privileges granted to The Saskatchewan Power Company by chapter 154 of the Statutes of Canada for the year 1908 as amended by chapter 148 of the Statutes of Canada for the year 1912; and for this purpose, if thought advisable, to purchase and acquire the stock or shares in the stock of the said The Saskatchewan Power Company and to apply to the Dominion Parliament for such legislation as may be considered necessary or desirable in connection therewith.

Authority to apply to Government of Canada for a charter

2 The city of Saskatoon is hereby authorised and empowered to apply to the Dominion Parliament for and to acquire, hold, use and enjoy a charter for the development of hydro-electric power on the South Saskatchewan river.
