**CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 44**  
*The Government Organization Act*  
and  
*The Department of Energy and Mines Act*

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Great Sand Hills Crown Disposition Assistance Regulations*.

**Interpretation**

**2** In these regulations:

- (a) “**affected area**” means the area designated in the Appendix to these regulations;
- (b) “**credit**” means financial assistance in the form of a credit granted pursuant to section 3;
- (c) “**Crown disposition**” means a Crown disposition as defined in *The Crown Minerals Act* that is wholly or partly in the affected area;
- (d) “**minister**” means the Minister of Energy and Mines.

**Grant of credit**

**3(1)** The minister may grant to every holder of a Crown disposition who surrenders to the minister all or a portion of the Crown disposition in accordance with this section financial assistance in the form of a credit of \$125 per acre surrendered.

(2) The amount of credit granted pursuant to subsection (1) is \$125 for each acre in the affected area that is covered by the portion of the Crown disposition being surrendered.

(3) The holder of a Crown disposition who wishes to surrender all or a portion of the Crown disposition shall enter into a written agreement with the minister that:

- (a) in the opinion of the minister, effectively surrenders the holder’s rights to explore or prospect for, or to any other right or interest in, Crown minerals covered by the Crown disposition; and
- (b) deals with any other matters that the minister considers appropriate.

(4) A holder of a Crown disposition who wishes to obtain a credit shall enter into the written agreement mentioned in subsection (3) within six months of the date that these regulations come into force.

GREAT SAND HILLS  
G-5.1 REG 44 CROWN DISPOSITION ASSISTANCE

**Use of credit**

4(1) The holder of a credit may use, until July 1, 1995, the credit to bid on and, if successful on the bid, acquire oil and gas rights that are offered for sale by the Crown under *The Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulations, 1969*, being Saskatchewan Regulations 8/69.

(2) The credits shall be used only in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in *The Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulations, 1969*, being Saskatchewan Regulations 8/69.

(3) All credits that are unused on July 1, 1995 are extinguished.

**Record of credits**

5(1) The minister shall cause a written record of all credits that have been granted to be kept by the department.

(2) In the event of a dispute between the minister and a holder of credits respecting the number and amount of credits, if any, held by the holder, the number and amount of credits as stated in the record kept pursuant to subsection (1) shall be the final source to determine the issue.

**Assigning of credit**

6(1) The holder of a credit may assign the credit to another person, but only if the assignment is made in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in the written agreement required pursuant to subsection 3(3).

(2) Notwithstanding section 4, the minister may refuse to accept a credit on a bid of oil and gas rights that has been assigned until a copy of the assignment, that is satisfactory to the minister and that is executed by the assignor and assignee, is provided to the minister.
