CHAPTER N-4.1 REG 2
The Non-profit Corporations Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Dalmeny Home For The Aged Regulations*.

Interpretation

2 In these regulations, “**corporation**” means Dalmeny Home for the Aged.

Permission granted

3 Dalmeny Home for the Aged, incorporated pursuant to chapter 107 of the *Statutes of Saskatchewan, 1950*, is hereby permitted to apply, pursuant to section 169 of *The Non-profit Corporations Act*, for a certificate of continuance, as a charitable corporation, in the name “Dalmeny Home for the Aged”.

Objects

4 The principal objects and aims of the corporation to propagate the gospel, and to manage, operate and provide residences, facilities, recreation, care and other services to senior citizens within the context of a Christian environment are continued.

Powers

5 The corporation continues to have the power to acquire, by gift or purchase, have, hold, possess and enjoy lands, tenements, hereditaments, rents, annuities and other real or personal property.
