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## CHAPTER S-29 REG 17

### *The Saskatchewan Medical Care Insurance Act*

#### **Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Saskatchewan Medical Association Dues Check-off Regulations, 1988*.

#### **Deductions required**

**2(1)** The minister shall:

(a) annually deduct from payments being made to a physician by the minister, with respect to insured services provided by him, an amount to be determined from time to time in an agreement made pursuant to section 48.1 of *The Saskatchewan Medical Care Insurance Act* for services rendered by the Saskatchewan Medical Association on behalf of physicians in Saskatchewan; and

(b) pay the amount deducted pursuant to clause (a) to the Saskatchewan Medical Association.

(2) Within 60 days of receiving a list mentioned in section 3 containing the names of physicians with respect to whom deductions shall be made, the minister shall make the deduction required by subsection (1) from payments being made to each of those physicians.

#### **Duties of Saskatchewan Medical Association**

**3(1)** On the request of the minister, the Saskatchewan Medical Association shall provide to the minister any information that the minister requires to carry out the minister's duties prescribed in section 2 and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall provide to the minister:

(a) prior to April 30 in each year, a list of names of those physicians with respect to whom deductions shall be made pursuant to these regulations, showing the amount to be deducted from payments being made to each of those physicians; and

(b) periodically after April 30 in each year, any amendments that are required to the list mentioned in clause (a).

(2) The Saskatchewan Medical Association shall, not less than 14 days prior to a deduction being made pursuant to section 2, advise the physician with respect to whom the deduction is to be made in writing of the effect of these regulations.

**Time requirements**

**4** Notwithstanding any other provision of these regulations, the fact that any time requirement prescribed in these regulations was not complied with does not invalidate the deduction that was made.
