## CHAPTER 6

### An Act respecting the Executive Council

#### Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Executive Council Act*.

#### Composition

2 There shall be an Executive Council for the Province of Saskatchewan which shall be composed of such persons and under such designations as the Lieutenant Governor thinks fit.

#### Lieutenant Governor appoints

3 The Lieutenant Governor may appoint under the Great Seal of the Province of Saskatchewan from among such persons as may be appointed members of the Executive Council the following officers to hold office during pleasure, that is to say: President of the Council, Provincial Treasurer, Attorney General, Minister of Agriculture, Minister of Municipal Affairs, Provincial Secretary, Minister of Natural Resources, Minister of Mineral Resources, Minister of Highways and Transportation, Minister of Public Works, Minister of Education, Minister of Co-operation and Co-operative Development, Minister of Labour, Minister of Public Health, Minister of Social Welfare and Rehabilitation and Minister of Telephones; and may by order in council from time to time prescribe the duties of the said officers and of the several departments over which they shall preside or to which several departments over which they shall preside or to which they shall belong and of the officers and clerks thereof.

#### Powers and duties, transfer of

4 Any of the powers and duties which have been heretofore or may be hereafter assigned by law to the officers now constituting or who may hereafter constitute the Executive Council may, by order in council, be assigned and transferred, either for a limited period or otherwise, to any other of the said officers by name or otherwise.

#### Great Seal

5 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may adopt and provide a Great Seal of the province and may change such seal.
