CHAPTER 61

An Act to amend The Vital Statistics Act

(Assented to November 6, 1987)

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Vital Statistics Amendment Act, 1987*.

2 *The Vital Statistics Act* is amended in the manner set forth ^H in this Act.

Section 10 amended

3 Subsection 10(6) is amended by adding “, and any reference to the parents on such a certificate shall be to the adoptive parents only” after “as changed”.

Section 40 amended

4 The following subsection is added after subsection 40(1):

“(1.1) Where the director is satisfied that the information is not to be used for an unlawful or improper purpose, he may include in a certificate issued pursuant to subsection (1) the surnames, given names and places of birth of the mother and father of the person, and the birth surname of the mother”.
