CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 100

The Government Organization Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Department of Culture, Youth and Recreation Regulations, 2002*.

Department continued

2 The department of the Government of Saskatchewan called the Department of Culture, Youth and Recreation is continued.

Objects and purposes

3 The objects and purposes of the Department of Culture, Youth and Recreation are:

- (a) to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister of Culture, Youth and Recreation may be exercised and carried out; and
- (b) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to:
 - (i) cultural, physical and social development;
 - (ii) preserving or enhancing the multicultural composition of Saskatchewan;
 - (iii) the cultural, physical and social development of youth;
 - (iv) conserving, preserving, managing, protecting and developing Saskatchewan's heritage; and
 - (v) conserving, preserving, managing, protecting and developing areas of prehistoric, environmental, recreational or archaeological interest or significance.
