CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 104

The Government Organization Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as The Department of Labour Regulations, 2002.

2 The department of the Government of Saskatchewan called the Department of Labour is continued.

Objects and purposes

- **3**(1) The objects and purposes of the Department of Labour are to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister of Labour may be exercised and carried out and, with respect to those objects and purposes, to do the following:
 - (a) to develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to workplace issues and labour-management issues;
 - (b) to develop, promote, implement and enforce employment standards;
 - (c) to develop, promote, implement and enforce policies and standards relating to workplaces and working conditions that are safe and healthy for employees.
- (2) The objects and purposes of the Department of Labour are to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister Responsible for the Status of Women may be exercised and carried out and, with respect to those objects and purposes, to monitor programs, services and initiatives of the Government of Saskatchewan to determine their impact on women and on families and to recommend modifications to those programs, services and initiatives.
