1 These regulations may be cited as *The Historic Sites Regulations*.

Constitution of historic sites

2 The lands described in the Appendix are hereby constituted historic sites to be known by the names set out in the Appendix.

BUFFALO RUBBING STONE HISTORIC SITE

Parcel "A" in the north-east quarter of Section 8, in Township 29, in Range 26, west of the Third Meridian, as shown on Plan No. 63 S 15284 in the Land Titles Office for the Saskatoon Land Registration District.

CHIMNEY COULEE HISTORIC SITE

Parcel "A" in the south-east quarter of Section 20, in Township 7, in Range 21, west of the Third Meridian, as shown on Plan No. 77 SC 08629 in the Land Titles Office for the Swift Current Land Registration District.

FORT PELLY #1 HISTORIC SITE
