**SASKATCHEWAN REGULATION 261/76**  
under *The Liquor Board Superannuation Act – Section 54*

The Liquor Board Superannuation Commission, pursuant to section 54 of The Liquor Board Superannuation Act, subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, hereby repeals the regulations approved by Orders in Council, 685/64, dated April 28, 1964, and 1611/65, dated September 28, 1965, and makes the following regulations, all effective September 1, 1976:

(1) Authorizing payment of a “special allowance” to be paid in addition to a normal superannuation allowance payable under the Liquor Board Superannuation Act to a superannuate other than a dependent child in receipt of an allowance of less than \$100 per month as of April 30, 1976, in an amount and subject to the following conditions:

(a) payment shall be calculated on the difference between the minimum of \$100 per month and the superannuation allowance in effect as of April 30, 1976. In calculating the “special allowance”, a superannuation allowance payable to a dependent child shall be excluded.

(b) payment, in the event a superannuate dies, or a widow remarries, shall be a proportionate part of the “special allowance” for that portion of the last month that the superannuate was eligible for a superannuation allowance.

(c) payment for each month shall be included with the cheque for the superannuation allowance for that month.

(d) payment shall not be made for any period that the superannuation allowance of a superannuate is suspended.

(e) payment shall cease upon the date that the superannuate becomes entitled to receive a pension under the Old Age Security Act (Canada).

(2) Directing that payments on account of the “special allowance” shall be charged to the Liquor Board Superannuation Fund and the Fund in turn shall be reimbursed by the Liquor Board.
