ORDER

(Filed November 26, 1973.)

Pursuant to the powers conferred on it by clause (a) of subsection (2) of Section 21, of The Snowmobile Act, 1973, the Highway Traffic Board hereby authorizes the operation of snowmobiles on the portions of all highways not lying within the limits of any city, town or village in the province for the purpose only of crossing a highway pursuant to the provisions of subsection (4) of Section 21 and subsection (7) of Section 15.
