10 Copy of any document registered or filed with the registration clerk30 cents per page or part thereof

Note: No additional fees are payable where the search is made pursuant to a request made to an appointed person outside Regina appointed under *The Bills of Sale Act, 1957* or *The Conditional Sale Act, 1957*, or made by telephone, telegraph or mail to the Registration Clerk, Court House, Regina.

- 11 Under *The Garage Keepers Act* in respect of any warrant and any seizure thereunder or any matter or thing incidental thereto
 - (a) the fees that may be charged are those set out in the second schedule of *The Distress Act*, R.R.S. 1953, Chapter 91 in so far as the fees are applicable to *The Garage Keepers Act*; and
 - (b) the expenses that may be charged, in addition to the fees, are the actual expenses reasonably incurred in the removal and delivery of the motor vehicle to the garage keeper.
