## CHAPTER A-18 REG 1

### *The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission Act*

#### **Title**

**1** These Regulations may be cited as *The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission Fees Regulations*.

#### **Interpretation**

**2** In these regulations, “**resident of Saskatchewan**” means a person who is a beneficiary within the meaning of *The Saskatchewan Hospitalization Act* or *The Saskatchewan Medical Care Insurance Act*.

#### **Treatment of non-residents**

**3** Where the commission provides treatment to any person who is not a resident of Saskatchewan, the commission may charge a fee for that treatment in any amount that is not more than the cost, as determined by the commission, of providing that treatment to that person.

#### **Conferences, workshops, etc.**

**4** Where the commission holds a conference, workshop, seminar or other public event, the commission may charge persons who attend the event a fee that is to be not more than an amount determined by the commission on the basis of the estimated cost of holding the event.

#### **Consulting services**

**5** Where the commission provides a consulting service, the commission may charge persons who receive that service a fee that is to be not more than an amount determined by the commission on the basis of the estimated cost of providing that service.

#### **Promotional materials**

**6** Where the commission provides promotional materials to any person, the commission may charge a fee for those materials in any amount that is not more than the cost, as determined by the commission, of providing those materials.
