CHAPTER C-50.2 REG 2

The Crown Minerals Act

Title

- 1 These regulations may be cited as *The Mineral Vesting Regulations, 1988*.

Mines and minerals vested

- 2 The following minerals are vested in Scurry-Rainbow Oil (Sask.) Ltd.:

An undivided one-fourth interest in all Oil and Gas Rights within, upon or under, Legal Subdivisions Three (3) and Four (4) of Section Seven (7), in Township Seven (7), in Range Ten (10), West of the Second Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, containing together Eighty (80) acres, more or less, according to Dominion Government survey thereof, down to a depth of Three Thousand and Fifty (3,050) feet below mean sea level.

The said Oil and Gas Rights were acquired under *The Oil and Gas Conservation, Stabilization and Development Act* by Instrument registered as No. 81R04415.
