CHAPTER C-50.2 REG 20

The Crown Minerals Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Crown Mineral Lands Transfer Regulations, 2000*.

Crown mineral lands transferred

2 The Crown mineral lands set out in the Appendix are transferred to Canadian Natural Resources Limited.

Appendix

FIRSTLY

All petroleum, natural gas and all other hydrocarbons, except coal and valuable stone, all other gases and mineral substances, whether liquid or solid and whether hydrocarbon or not, occurring in association with any of the foregoing to a depth of 2660 feet below mean sea level as defined by section 27 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation, Stabilization, and Development Act, 1973* within, upon or under the South East Quarter of Section 13, Township 3, Range 2, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, 161 acres.

SECONDLY

All mines and minerals within, upon or under the North East Quarter of Section 12, Township 3, Range 2, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, 161 acres.
