CHAPTER C-50.2 REG 6

The Crown Minerals Act

Title

- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Mineral Vesting Regulations, 1994*.

Mines and minerals vested

- 2** The following mines and minerals are vested in Canco Oil & Gas Ltd.:
- (a) all mines and minerals within, upon or under the whole of the north-west quarter of Section 26, Township 6, Range 31, West of the First Meridian, Saskatchewan, 160 acres;
 - (b) an undivided four-fifths interest in all mines and minerals within, upon or under the whole of the south-east quarter of Section 35, Township 4, Range 1, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, 160 acres;
 - (c) an undivided four-fifths interest in all mines and minerals within, upon or under the whole of the north-east quarter of Section 22, Township 5, Range 2, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, 160 acres;
 - (d) all mines and minerals within, upon or under the whole of Legal Subdivisions 3 and 4, in Section 27, Township 6, Range 4, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, 80 acres; and
 - (e) all mines and minerals within, upon or under the whole of Legal Subdivisions 9 and 10, in Section 5, Township 6, Range 5, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, 80 acres.
