**CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 48**  
*The Government Organization Act*

**Title**

- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Women's Secretariat Regulations, 1992*.

**Secretariat continued**

- 2** The secretariat of the Government of Saskatchewan called the Women's Secretariat is continued.

**Objects and purposes**

- 3** The objects and purposes of the Women's Secretariat are:

- (a) to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, duties and functions of the Minister responsible for the Status of Women may be exercised and carried out;
- (b) to co-ordinate, promote, develop and implement policies, programs and activities relating to the status of women;
- (c) to develop, co-ordinate and promote policies and programs relating to the equity, enhancement and social well-being of family relationships in Saskatchewan;
- (d) to monitor programs, services and initiatives of the Government of Saskatchewan to determine their impact on women and on families and to recommend modifications to those programs, services and initiatives.
