CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 93

The Government Organization Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Department of Culture*, Youth and Recreation Regulations (No. 2).

 - (b) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to:
 - (i) cultural, physical and social development;
 - (ii) preserving or enhancing the multicultural composition of Saskatchewan;
 - (iii) the cultural, physical and social development of youth.
