**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Liquor (Certificate of Analysis) Regulations*.

**Certificate of analysis**

**2** The certificate of analysis used by a person appointed as an analyst for the purpose of analysing liquor under *The Liquor Act* is to be in the form set out in the Appendix.
