CHAPTER P-50 REG 1

The Pyramid Franchises Act

Title

- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Pyramid Franchises Regulations*.

Interpretation

- 2** In these regulations, “**Act**” means *The Pyramid Franchises Act*.

Licence fee

- 3** The fee for a licence under the Act is \$200.

Exemption from section 3 of Act

- 4** A franchisor is exempt from section 3 of the Act where:

(a) pursuant to the terms of a pyramid franchise agreement or other contract or agreement, express or implied, oral or written, he does not require the franchisee to:

(i) pay a franchise fee; and

(ii) purchase goods in an amount that exceeds \$200;

(b) he files with the registrar two copies of each form of pyramid franchise or other contract or agreement to be used, and the registrar gives written approval of the forms; and

(c) the registrar is of the opinion that it is not in the public interest to license the franchisor.
