CHAPTER Q-1 REG 10

The Queen's Bench Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Queen's Bench Judges Residence Regulations*.

Residence of judges

2 For the purpose of subsection 7.1(3) of *The Queen's Bench Act*, the following are designated as the places where the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall ensure that at least one judge resides at or in the neighbourhood of:

- (a) Battleford;
- (b) Estevan;
- (c) Humboldt;
- (d) Moose Jaw;
- (e) Prince Albert;
- (f) Regina;
- (g) Saskatoon;
- (h) Swift Current;
- (i) Yorkton.
