CHAPTER S-46.1 REG 1

The Senior Citizens' Heritage Rebates Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Senior Citizens' Heritage Rebates Regulations*.

Interpretation

2 In these regulations, "**Act**" means *The Senior Citizens' Heritage Rebates Act*.

Definitions of terms used in Act

3 For the purposes of the Act:

- (a) "**commercial enterprise**" includes the renting of a dwelling or farm land;
- (b) "**home quarter**" means:
 - (i) subject to subclause (ii), the quarter section of farm land on which the applicant's principal residence is located; or
 - (ii) where the applicant's principal residence is located on farm land owned by another person, the quarter section of farm land operated by the applicant that has the highest taxable assessment;
- (c) "**non-profit corporation**" means a corporation, the articles, bylaws or incorporating documents of which prohibit the payment of a dividend to its members or shareholders and, in the event of dissolution, prohibit the distribution of any or all of its assets or property to its members or shareholders;
- (d) "**proprietary lease**" includes a housing agreement between a housing co-operative and its members.

Definitions of terms used in Act and regulations

4 For the purposes of the Act and these regulations:

- (a) "**member of a co-operative association**" and "**shareholder in a corporation**" mean a person who is entitled to full voting rights in a co-operative association established or continued pursuant to *The Co-operatives Act*;
- (b) "**trust**" means:
 - (i) a life estate established under the terms of a will or court order; or

(ii) that situation that exists when the minister is satisfied that an applicant for a grant will become the registered owner of land pursuant to the probate or administration of the estate of which he is a beneficiary.

Documentation to accompany application for grant

5(1) Subject to subsection (2), every applicant for a grant shall include with his application:

- (a) a copy or reasonable facsimile of the tax notice issued by a municipality or the mortgagee with respect to his principal residence, business or farm;
- (b) a receipt, certificate or other authentic document, indicating that an amount equal to the 1985 general property tax with respect to the principal residence, business or farm has been paid to the municipality prior to the date of application and not later than February 28, 1986; and
- (c) in the case of an application with respect to a trust, any satisfactory evidence of the trust that the minister considers advisable.

(2) Every applicant for a grant who is a member of a co-operative association, or a shareholder in a corporation, that is engaged in farming shall include with his application a certificate in a form approved by the minister and signed by the secretary of the co-operative association, or the corporation, indicating the proportionate interest of the applicant with respect to the assessment and taxation of the association or corporation.
