SASKATCHEWAN REGULATION 198/75
under *The Agricultural Machinery Institute Act, 1974 – Section 23*

Short Title

1 These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Machinery Institute Regulations.

Definitions

2 In these regulations the expression:

- (1) “**Act**” means The Agricultural Machinery Institute Act, 1974.
- (2) “**Minister**” means the Minister of Agriculture for Saskatchewan.

Head Office

3(1) The institute shall establish and maintain a head office in Humboldt, Saskatchewan and shall make the location thereof known to those persons carrying on business with the institute.

Corporate Seal

4 The institute may adopt a corporate seal approved by the council.

Jurisdiction of the Institute

5 The institute may exercise its powers to carry out its purposes, objectives, functions and operations anywhere in the provinces of Saskatchewan, Alberta and Manitoba as agreed to by the provinces in an agreement signed by the Ministers of Agriculture for the provinces of Saskatchewan, Alberta and Manitoba and dated October 10, 1974 subject to any amendment or substitution therefore, and in such other provinces the Ministers of Agriculture of such provinces agree by agreement under Section 21 of the Act.

Surplus Funds

6 The Council may set a specific limit on the operating surplus to be carried by the institute and authorize the refund of amounts in excess of the operating surplus limit to the signatory provinces, as outlined in section 5 herein, in proportion to their contributions to the institute as specified in the agreement of October 10, 1974 and any subsequent amendment.
