CHAPTER 99

**An Act to provide for Tax Exemption of Certain Property of Bethel
Bible Institute, of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan**

(Assented to April 1, 1939)

Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for an Act of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan to provide for permanent exemption of the property hereinafter mentioned from all taxes, rates, levies and assessment of every nature and kind save and except special assessment taxes under Part XII of *The City Act*; and

Whereas the City of Saskatoon has by resolution consented to such exemption; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1 All real property of Bethel Bible Institute, of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, not exceeding one acre and situated outside of the business area of the City of Saskatoon, as defined by the zoning bylaw of the said city and all personal property of the institute, now or hereafter acquired, shall, while used for theological college or seminary purposes, and for no other purpose, be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessment of every nature and kind save and except special assessment taxes under Part XII of *The City Act*.
