CHAPTER 64

**An Act to provide for Exemption from Taxation of Certain Property of
Canadian Bible College of the Christian and Missionary Alliance**

(Assented to March 17, 1964)

Preamble

WHEREAS Canadian Bible College of The Christian and Missionary Alliance has presented a petition praying for an Act of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan to provide for exemption, effective from the first day of January, 1964, of the property hereinafter mentioned from all general taxation but not from local improvement taxes and special charges; and

Whereas the council of The City of Regina has by resolution consented to such exemption; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1 All property, real and personal, not including the lands and buildings thereon used as private residences, of Canadian Bible College of the Christian and Missionary Alliance, situated in the city of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, now owned or hereafter acquired and used in connection with and for the purposes of the said college, shall while used for religious and educational purposes, be exempt, effective from the first day of January, 1964, from all general taxation but not from local improvement taxes and special charges.
