CHAPTER 95

An Act to exempt Luther College of Regina from Taxation

(Assented to March 23, 1938)

Preamble

WHEREAS the Board of Management of the Canadian District of the American Lutheran Church, has presented a petition praying that the property, real and personal, now owned or hereafter acquired by the said Board and used in connection with and for the purposes of Luther College of Regina, should while used for educational purposes be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind, save and except special frontage assessment taxes under *The City Act*; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the said prayer:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1 All property real and personal of the board of Management of the Canadian District of the American Lutheran Church, now owned or hereafter acquired and used in connection with and for the purposes of Luther College of Regina, shall while used for educational purposes be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind, save and except special frontage assessment taxes under Part XII of *The City Act*.
