CHAPTER 79

**An Act to provide for Exemption from Taxation of Certain Property of
The Ukrainian Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Saskatchewan**

(Assented to April 5, 1956)

Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for an Act of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan to provide for permanent exemption of the property hereinafter listed from all taxes, levies and assessments save and except local improvement taxes; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1 All of the land included in lots thirty-five (35), thirty-six (36), thirty-seven (37), thirty-eight (38), thirty-nine (39) and forty (40) in block thirty-five (35) in the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, according to a plan of record in the land titles office for the Saskatoon Land Registration District as No. (F.W.) F. 5527 together with all buildings erected thereon so long as the same shall remain the property of The Ukrainian Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Saskatchewan and used in the educational and religious activities of the said The Ukrainian Catholic Episcopal Corporation of Saskatchewan shall be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind save and except special assessments under paragraph 48 of subsection (1) of section 235 and Part VIII of *The City Act*.
