CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 147

The Government Organization Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Information Technology Office Regulations, 2007*.

Office continued

2 The department of the Government of Saskatchewan called the Information Technology Office is continued.

Objects and purposes

3 The objects and purposes of the Information Technology Office are the following:

- (a) to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister Responsible for Information Technology Office may be exercised and carried out;
- (b) to develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to information technology and information management;
- (c) to develop, procure and provide goods and services related to information technology and information management on behalf of the Government of Saskatchewan and to charge ministries for those goods and services;
- (d) to co-ordinate, develop and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to telecommunications, broadband, broadcasting and cable services;
- (e) to develop, implement, monitor and enforce security policies and standards of the Government of Saskatchewan respecting information technology and information management;
- (f) to develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to geomatics;
- (g) to co-ordinate, develop and manage the Government of Saskatchewan's worldwide website on the Internet.
