

The Meewasin Valley Authority Act

MEEWASIN BYLAW NO. 4 – DOG BYLAW
BEAVER CREEK CONSERVATION DEVELOPMENT AREA

It is unlawful for a person who owns, has an interest in, harbors or has charge, care, control, custody or possession of a dog, to permit the dog to be in or upon the area known as Beaver Creek Conservation Area and described in Schedule "A" of *The Meewasin Valley Authority Act*, unless he has written consent of the Chief Executive Officer of Meewasin Valley Authority or has a working seeing-eye dog.

Any peace officer may enforce this bylaw.

A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, shall be liable to a minimum fine of \$100.

A violator of this bylaw, upon being served with a Notice of Violation may, within 10 days, voluntarily pay the penalty to the Rural Municipality of Corman Park or Meewasin Valley Authority, and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not be liable to prosecution of the offence.

The notice of violation shall be Form "1" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
