CHAPTER D-4 REG 3

The Dental Care Act

Title

- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Dental Care Beneficiary Regulations, 1987*.

Beneficiaries designated

2(1) Subject to subsection (4), any person who is 16 years of age or less and who resides in the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District is designated for the purposes of clause 2(a) of *The Dental Care Act* as a member of the class of persons who are beneficiaries.

(4) In the year in which a person who resides in the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District resides attains the age of 17 years he is designated for the purpose of clause 2(a) of *The Dental Care Act* as a member of the class of persons who are beneficiaries only for that portion of the year from January 1 to August 31.
