CHAPTER O-4.2 REG 1

The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Regulations*.

Interpretation

2 In these regulations, “**Act**” means *The Operation of Public Registry Statutes Act*.

3 For the purposes of clause 2(2)(q) of the Act, the following are designated as Acts with respect to which a service agreement may be entered into:

- (a) *The Common Business Identifiers Act*;
- (b) *The Credit Union Act, 1985*;
- (c) *The Credit Union Act, 1998*.

Coming into force

4(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on October 19, 2013.

(2) If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after October 19, 2013, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
