CHAPTER 58

An Act to provide for the Exemption from Taxation of Certain Property
of The Society of the Sisters of Sion

(Assented to March 25, 1924)

Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for the exemption from taxation of certain lands; and Whereas the City of Saskatoon has, by resolution, consented to such exemption; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioner:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1 Sion Convent, an academy operated by The Society of the Sisters of Sion, in the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, the lands on which it is situated, namely, Parcel E as on a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office for the Saskatoon Land Registration District No. B.V. 6120, and the personal property of the said corporation shall, while used for academy and convent purposes be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind, save and except special frontage assessment taxes under Part XII of *The City Act*.
