

**Seismic Activity Policy  
Agricultural Crown Lands  
February 2018**

**A. Purpose**

To provide a procedure to be followed by companies conducting seismic operations on agricultural Crown lands.

**B. Conditions**

1. Land under lease: companies conducting seismic work must obtain a seismic licence from the Ministry. The company must negotiate compensation for right of entry, adverse effects, nuisance and productivity loss with the lessee.
2. Land not under lease: companies conducting work must obtain approval from the Ministry prior to entry. Payment to the Ministry for seismic work shall be \$700 per mile on cultivated land and \$400 per mile on grazing land. The charge for access only shall be \$300 per mile. There shall be a minimum charge of one half mile per quarter.
3. Seismic work must be conducted in accordance with the Seismic Activity Guidelines.

**C. General**

Compensation for damages to crops, fences, etc. is not included in the above. The company responsible for the damages is required to pay for such damages directly to the lessee as they occur.
