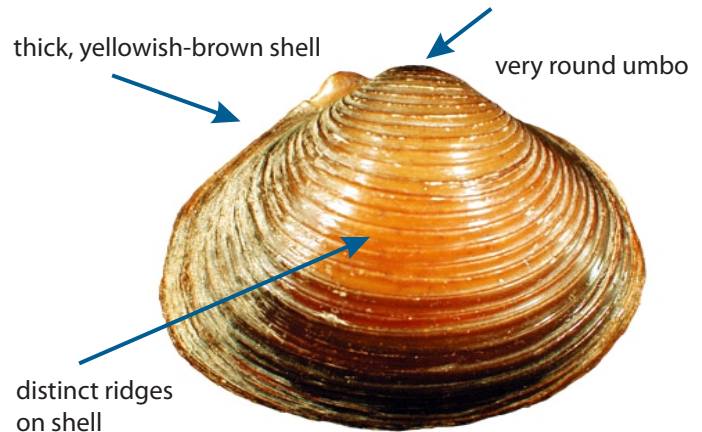


# Asian Clam

Asian clam has been detected in the Great Lakes as well as waters in British Columbia and 40 U.S. states.

## Clean, drain and dry



Asian clams can spread between waterbodies on watercrafts and gear that have not been properly cleaned, drained and dried. **Inspect your boat and gear after every use to stop the spread!**

Asian clams compete with native species for food and habitat and can cause **millions of dollars in damage** to intake pipes used for power and water industries.

Asian clams were introduced to North America as a food source for humans and have been **spread by the aquaculture industry and aquarium dumping**.

## Don't let it loose!



**It is illegal** to release aquarium water, plants or animals into the wild.

## Prohibited Species

It is illegal to buy, sell, possess, import or transport Asian clams in Saskatchewan.
