Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

June 2016

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering June 12th to 18th, 2016, there were 582,200 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 4,400 from May 2016 but 6,900 less than the number employed in June 2015.

Agricultural employment was 43,200 persons in June 2016, down 700 from the May 2016 level but 2,800 more than the June 2015 agricultural employment level of 40,400. Non-agricultural employment was 539,000 persons in June 2016. This is an increase of 5,100 from the May 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 533,900 but 9,700 less than June 2015.

The Saskatchewan <u>unemployment rate</u> for June 2016 was 5.5 percent. This is a decrease of 0.3 percentage points from the May 2016 rate of 5.8 percent but 1.3 percentage points higher than the June 2015 level of 4.2 percent.

Saskatchewan's <u>labour force</u> increased by 2,700 to 616,200 persons in June 2016 from 613,500 persons in May 2016. This is 1,300 more than the June 2015 labour force of 614,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.3 percentage points to 71.0 percent in June 2016 from 70.7 percent in May 2016. The June 2015 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 71.4 percent.

There were 34,000 persons <u>unemployed</u> in Saskatchewan during June 2016. This is a decrease of 1,800 from May 2016 but is 8,200 more than the number unemployed in June 2015.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a <u>seasonally adjusted</u> basis there were 569,900 persons <u>employed</u> in Saskatchewan in June 2016, up 1,000 from the May 2016 level of 568,900 and down 6,200 from the June 2015 employment level of 576,100 persons.

The Saskatchewan <u>seasonally adjusted</u> <u>unemployment rate</u> for June 2016 was 6.1 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the May 2016 rate of 6.0 percent and 1.3 percentage points higher than the June 2015 rate of 4.8 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian <u>employment</u> increased by 151,900 persons in June 2016 to 18,410,600 persons from 18,258,700 persons in May 2016. In June 2015, there were 18,314,600 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's <u>unemployment rate</u> decreased 0.5 percentage points in June 2016 to 6.4 percent from the May 2016 level of 6.9 percent. In June 2015, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.5 percent.

The <u>seasonally adjusted</u> unemployment rate for Canada was 6.8 percent in June 2016. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than May 2016 but the same as the June 2015 level of 6.8 percent.
