

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

September 2016

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering September 11th to 17th, 2016, there were 573,400 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 1,300 from August 2016 and 6,000 less than the number employed in September 2015.

Agricultural employment was 43,700 persons in September 2016, down 1,200 from the August 2016 level and 500 less than the September 2015 agricultural employment level of 44,200. Non-agricultural employment was 529,700 persons in September 2016. This is a decrease of 100 from the August 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 529,800 and 5,500 less than September 2015.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for September 2016 was 5.9 percent. This is a decrease of 0.9 percentage points from the August 2016 rate of 6.8 percent but 1.5 percentage points higher than the September 2015 level of 4.4 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 7,100 to 609,500 persons in September 2016 from 616,600 persons in August 2016. This is 3,700 more than the September 2015 labour force of 605,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.8 percentage points to 70.0 percent in September 2016 from 70.8 percent in August 2016. The September 2015 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 70.2 percent.

There were 36,100 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during September 2016. This is a decrease of 5,900 from August 2016 but is 9,700 more than the number unemployed in September 2015.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 569,300 persons employed in Saskatchewan in September 2016, up 300 from the August 2016 level of 569,000 and is down 6,500 from the September 2015 employment level of 575,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for September 2016 was 6.8 percent. This is an increase of 0.5 percentage points from the August 2016 rate of 6.3 percent and 1.6 percentage points higher than the September 2015 rate of 5.2 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 84,500 persons in September 2016 to 18,212,100 persons from 18,296,600 persons in August 2016. In September 2015, there were 18,068,700 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 1.2 percentage points in September 2016 to 6.4 percent from the August 2016 level of 7.6 percent. In September 2015, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.4 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.0 percent in September 2016. This is the same as August 2016 but 0.1 percentage points lower than the September 2015 level of 7.1 percent.
