

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

September 2015

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering September 13th to 19th, 2015, there were 579,400 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 700 from August 2015 and 1,400 more than the number employed in September 2014.

Agricultural employment was 44,200 persons in September 2015, up 2,200 from the August 2015 level but 3,800 less than the September 2014 agricultural employment level of 48,000. Non-agricultural employment was 535,200 persons in September 2015. This is a decrease of 1,500 from the August 2015 non-agriculture employment level of 536,700 but 5,200 more than September 2014.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for September 2015 was 4.4 percent. This is a decrease of 1.6 percentage points from the August 2015 rate of 6.0 percent but 1.5 percentage points higher than the September 2014 level of 2.9 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 9,700 to 605,800 persons in September 2015 from 615,500 persons in August 2015. This is 10,400 more than the September 2014 labour force of 595,400 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 1.1 percentage points to 70.2 percent in September 2015 from 71.3 percent in August 2015. The September 2014 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.6 percent.

There were 26,400 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during September 2015. This is a decrease of 10,400 from August 2015 but is 9,100 more than the number unemployed in September 2014.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 575,900 persons employed in Saskatchewan in September 2015, up 3,200 from the August 2015 level of 572,700 and is up 300 from the September 2014 employment level of 575,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for September 2015 was 5.1 percent. This is an increase of 0.4 percentage points from the August 2015 rate of 4.7 percent and 1.6 percentage points higher than the September 2014 rate of 3.5 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 160,100 persons in September 2015 to 18,068,700 persons from 18,228,800 persons in August 2015. In September 2014, there were 17,915,100 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 1.1 percentage points in September 2015 to 6.4 percent from the August 2015 level of 7.5 percent. In September 2014, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.3 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.1 percent in September 2015. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than August 2015 and 0.2 percentage points higher than the September 2014 level of 6.9 percent.
