

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

November 2015

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering November 8th to 14th, 2015, there were 577,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 2,200 from October 2015 and 7,200 more than the number employed in November 2014.

Agricultural employment was 41,800 persons in November 2015, down 2,300 from the October 2015 level and 200 more than the November 2014 agricultural employment level of 41,600. Non-agricultural employment was 526,000 persons in November 2015. This is an increase of 100 from the October 2015 non-agriculture employment level of 535,900 and 7,000 more than November 2014.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for November 2015 was 5.0 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the October 2015 rate of 4.9 percent and 1.8 percentage points higher than the November 2014 level of 3.2 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 1,600 to 608,300 persons in November 2015 from 609,900 persons in October 2015. This is 18,700 more than the November 2014 labour force of 589,600 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.2 percentage points to 70.4 percent in November 2015 from 70.6 percent in October 2015. The November 2014 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 68.9 percent.

There were 30,500 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during November 2015. This is an increase of 600 from October 2015 and is 11,400 more than the number unemployed in November 2014.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 579,700 persons employed in Saskatchewan in November 2015, up 2,400 from the October 2015 level of 577,300 and is up 6,000 from the November 2014 employment level of 573,700 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for November 2015 was 5.5 percent. This is a decrease of 0.1 percentage points from the October 2015 rate of 5.6 percent and 2.1 percentage points higher than the November 2014 rate of 3.4 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 101,100 persons in November 2015 to 17,993,200 persons from 18,094,300 persons in October 2015. In November 2014, there were 17,871,200 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate increased 0.3 percentage points in November 2015 to 6.6 percent from the October 2015 level of 6.3 percent. In November 2014, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.2 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 7.1 percent in November 2015. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than October 2015 and 0.4 percentage points higher than the November 2014 level of 6.7 percent.
