

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2008

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended October 18, 2008, there were 521,600 persons employed in Saskatchewan during October 2008, a decrease of 900 from September 2008 but 17,100 more than the number employed in October 2007.

Agricultural employment was 41,100 persons in October 2008, down 6,100 from the September 2008 level and 1,900 less than the October 2007 agricultural employment level of 43,000. Non-agricultural employment was 480,500 persons in October 2008. This is an increase of 5,200 from the September 2008 non-agriculture employment level of 475,300 and 19,000 more than October 2007.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for October 2008 was 3.3 percent. This is a decrease of 0.3 percentage points from the September 2008 rate of 3.6 percent and 0.4 percentage points lower than the October 2007 level of 3.7 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 2,900 to 539,200 persons in October 2008 from 542,100 persons in September 2008. This is 15,200 more than the October 2007 labour force of 524,000 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 0.5 percentage points to 69.8 percent in October 2008 from 70.3 percent in September 2008. The October 2007 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.4 percent.

There were 17,600 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during October 2008. This is a decrease of 2,000 from September 2008 and is 1,900 less than the number unemployed in October 2007.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 519,300 persons employed in Saskatchewan in October 2008, up 100 from the September 2008 level of 519,200 and is up 16,200 from the October 2007 employment level of 503,100 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2008 was 4.0 percent. This is a decrease of 0.1 percentage points from the September 2008 rate of 4.1 percent and 0.3 percentage points lower than the October 2007 rate of 4.3 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 40,500 persons in October 2008 to 17,270,700 persons from 17,230,200 persons in September 2008. In October 2007, there were 17,051,900 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.1 percentage points to 5.6 percent from the September 2008 level of 5.7 percent. In October 2007, Canada's unemployment rate was 5.3 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.2 percent in October 2008. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than September 2008 and 0.4 percentage points higher than the October 2007 level of 5.8 percent.
