

# Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

May 2017

## UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering May 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, there were 579,100 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is an increase of 19,000 from April 2017 and 1,300 more than the number employed in May 2016.

Agricultural employment was 39,600 persons in May 2017, up 2,900 from the April 2017 level but 4,300 less than the May 2016 agricultural employment level of 43,900. Non-agricultural employment was 539,500 persons in May 2017. This is an increase of 16,100 from the April 2017 non-agriculture employment level of 523,400 and 5,600 more than May 2016.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for May 2017 was 6.3 percent. This is a decrease of 0.7 percentage points from the April 2017 rate of 7.0 percent but 0.5 percentage points higher than the May 2016 level of 5.8 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 15,600 to 618,100 persons in May 2017 from 602,500 persons in April 2017. This is 4,600 more than the May 2016 labour force of 613,500 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 1.7 percentage points to 70.5 percent in May 2017 from 68.8 percent in April 2017. The May 2016 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 70.7 percent.

There were 39,000 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during May 2017. This is an decrease of 3,400 from April 2017 but is 3,200 more than the number unemployed in May 2016.

## SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 570,300 persons employed in Saskatchewan in May 2017, up 2,100 from the April 2017 level of 568,200 and is up 1,600 from the May 2016 employment level of 568,700 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for May 2017 was 6.3 percent. This is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from the April 2017 rate of 6.2 percent and 0.3 percentage points higher than the May 2016 rate of 6.0 percent.

## CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment increased by 478,000 persons in May 2017 to 18,575,000 persons from 18,097,000 persons in April 2017. In May 2016, there were 18,258,700 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 0.2 percentage points in May 2017 to 6.6 percent from the April 2017 level of 6.8 percent. In May 2016, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.9 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.6 percent in May 2017. This is 0.1 percentage points higher than April 2017 but 0.3 percentage points lower than the May 2016 level of 6.9 percent.
